I will be holding a meeting for Year 6 parents on Wednesday 26th April at 5.00p.m. and for year 2 parents on Thursday 11th May at 5.00p.m. to explain the basic purpose and forms of the test, how you can support your child and how the results will be reported.

If your child is not in these year groups but you would still like to come along you are more than welcome. This isn't really an event

where you can bring your children as it will be lots of information and possibly questions, obviously I am aware that on occasion it is unavoidable due to lack of child care, if you do have to bring your child I would ask you to ensure they can sit quietly with something to entertain themselves. I am expecting the session to last approximately 45 minutes.





The next 'Tea and Talk' session will take place in the hall on Wednesday 24th May at 2.00p.m. the focus will be on how your child learns maths, we will be showing you some of the teaching methods we use and there will be again the opportunities for you to ask any questions.
