Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the final term of the year.

We have an incredibly busy term ahead of us, particularly for year 6 who have lots to fit in before leaving us for the next part of their learning journeys.

This term we have: phonics screening, sports week, class trips, key stage trips, bikeability, thank you tea party, sports day, school reports, leavers disco and leaver's service to name just a few of the activities we will be participating in.

Whilst Hurstwood, Kemsley and Oakwood are continuing their topics from the previous term: Rainforests, Harry Potter and Eragon. Fir tree and Forge have both begun their new topics of:- Spot the difference between countries and Happy Holidays.

The final arrangements for key stage 2 for September have now been put in place. The children will be working mainly within their year group for maths and English in the morning.
