

The children all carried out workshops in the cathedral, learning about both the peace project and the cathedral itself. We also visited the Guildhall Museum, where we discovered what life would have been like for prisoners held in the hulks and the castle where we learned about how the castle would have been a fortress, protecting the city. The children's behaviour was impeccable as usual, with their good manners, excellent behaviours and thoughtful questions being commented on by several of the staff running the events for us.

On Wednesday Mrs Carey accompanied the choir to The Central Theatre in Chatham, where they participated in the Medway Music Association for KS2 Festival, along with other local schools. The children performed 12 songs on stage and sang incredibly beautifully. They were a credit to our school.

Thursday saw two KS2 football teams play matches at St.John's Primary School in Maidstone. Our children persevered in both of their matches but unluckily both teams suffered a loss. 
