Dear Parents and Carers.

I am pleased to say that year 6 have now finished their SATS tests. It felt like a very long four days, with the reading paper being amongst

the most difficult I have seen. However, the children used all the strategies they have been taught and the knowledge they have acquired over the past 4 years of their education to answer the questions in the tests throughout the week. Every child should be extremely proud of the way they conducted themselves this week during the testing. They showed the values of perseverance and self control throughout the whole of the testing and all worked their hardest and gave their absolute best all week. Well done year 6 - I am so proud of each and everyone of you. You have impressed us all this week with how hard you have worked and how calmly you have dealt with the week of testing.



Next week year 2 will be sitting their SATS tests, these tests will take place each morning next week. We ask that the children in Forge class arrive at school promptly next week in order to ensure a smooth start to the day. Please try to ensure your child is not worried by these assessments as they are just a snapshot of your child's learning, certainly not the whole picture of your child and the children have been taught the areas they will be tested on. These are carried out in a much more informal way than the year 6 tests due to the age of the children, they really do have nothing to worry about.

The results for both year 2 and year 6 SATS tests will be in the children's final school reports, in July. The results for year 6 will not be released by the DfE until approx. 8th July so the results will not be available before the reports are sent out.

Next Saturday (20th) is May Day, therefore on Thursday and Friday we will be practising both the pageant and the dances. The whole school may come into school in their PE kits for both days.

There is also a signing up sheet on the front playground for donations needed for the actual day. Please drop any donations into the school office whenever it suits you, but by 9.30am on Saturday. However, please do not feel obliged to donate.

A reminder of the protocol for next week: All children are to arrive at St. Peter's Church between 10.30 and 10.45, dressed in their May



Day costume. The school staff will be ready to greet them and organise them for the procession to school. As the children proceed to the school, we ask that parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles and friends and families line the road and cheer and clap them on their way. Once the children enter the front gate at the school they will wait until all spectators have walked around to the large gate on The Street, leading to the field. We ask that everyone enters via this gate unless they have a disability; Mrs. Place will be on the front gate to ensure those with a disability are able to enter the school via this entrance. Please can I remind you that unfortunately the staff car park is strictly out of bounds for the entire event as staff will be parking there and they may need to be able to leave and return to the school during the event. Please be mindful where you park as the whole area will be very busy and local residents will need to be able to have easy access to their homes.

The swimming pool is now ready for use - we are just awaiting the warmer weather - Spring does still seem to be a long way off! Hopefully the sun will start to make more of an appearance and we will be able to start our swimming lessons soon.
