We will let you know the dates for the remaining weeks after the half term break. Please make sure your child's form is returned for swimming as they will not be able to swim with out this consent form.



Year 5 parents, you should have had a letter regarding the Kent and Medway test, with an opportunity for you to have an individual appointment to discuss the test for your child. If your child will not be sitting either the Kent or Medway test you do need to apply for a place. This registration is only to register your child to sit the Kent and Medway test so you only need to complete the form for Medway/Kent tests at this time. Registration for both the Kent and Medway Test for children due to **start secondary school in September 2024** will open on Thursday 1 June 2023 and will close at midnight on Monday 3 July 2023. I will be holding a meeting for year 5 parents in September regarding how to apply for secondary school places.

I have had several parents ask about Sports Day; our plan is to run it the same as last year, with the infant children taking part in their races in the morning, starting at approx. 10.00 and the junior children starting once the infants have finished - which should be approx.



11.15. The junior children will be able to watch the infants and cheer them on. All parents may watch both infant and junior races. Once the infant children have raced they may sit with parents to watch the junior children in their races. We are inviting you to join your child/children for a picnic after the sports day events. We will have no hot meals that day, although your child will be able to order a sandwich lunch. After the picnic lunch parents will be free to take their child or alternatively you may leave them at school until the end of the day. Any child whose parents are unable to attend will stay in school as normal.
