Dear Parents and Carers,

The week started with odd socks and ended with spotty ears!

As part of **friendship week** (as well as the odd socks to celebrate our differences), the children were all reminded about what to do if someone is unkind to them and how to help if they see someone being unkind. They were reminded how to be a good friend and how a good friend behaves and what to do if you are being bullied or someone is unkind to you. Hopefully the message has been reinforced this week with the children being reminded to get an adult to help them if someone does or says something to them that they do not like, as we can only deal with things if we know they are happening. They have been told to tell an adult at school or home to help them should this happen. The children across the school are very good at looking out for each other and are very inclusive in their play.
