## Dear Parents and Carers,

Well, it has certainly been a rather busy week following on from our phone call from Oftsed on Monday afternoon. We had our two day inspection on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. The inspectors went into all classes, looked at children's work and spoke with the children. Our children were as amazing as ever, being confident and articulate when spoken to. I was incredibly proud of them all. The report and judgments about the provision the school provides will be released in approx. 5– 6 weeks, until then we are unable to share any of the findings or judgments from the report with you.

On Thursday Hurstwood class led us in a worship about love and kindness and how every bit of love we receive in a day fills our glass and how every bit of love we give in a day fills someone elses glass, this followed on the from the worship held on Monday about the woman at the well. I am not sure how Miss Meade managed to plan and organise a class worship in the middle of an inspection - I was very impressed that she did! Our children spoke very clearly and understood the message they were sharing with our school community very well. Thank you to all the parents who joined us.

Last Friday some of our year 5 and 6 children represented the school in the Mini Youth Games Swimming Competition. Mr Peters said they all behaved impeccably and were fantastic at supporting each other. Amelia Martin was one of our star performers for the day, coming in 3rd place out of over 80 swimmers in breaststroke and 4th in backstroke. We also had two great swims from Luca Suvari who came in the top 30 for his butterfly out of 60 swimmers and 20th for his breaststroke out of 80. We finished the day in 9th position, which was a great result, especially considering the size of the other 30 schools who took part in the competition. Well done to all our swimmers: Luca Suvari, Luke Wallace, Austin Humphries, Jacob Knowles, Ella Hyland, Amelia Martin, Alba-Lily Peters and Mia Jones. You all represented the school incredibly well.
